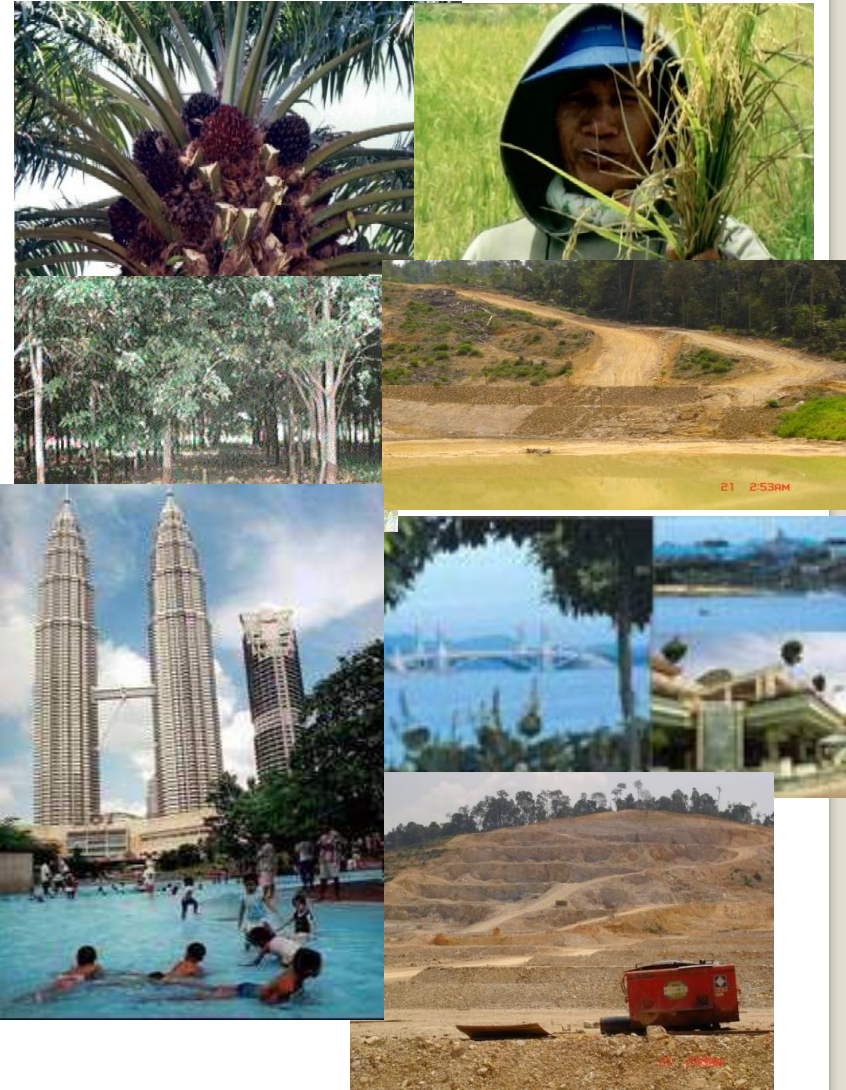


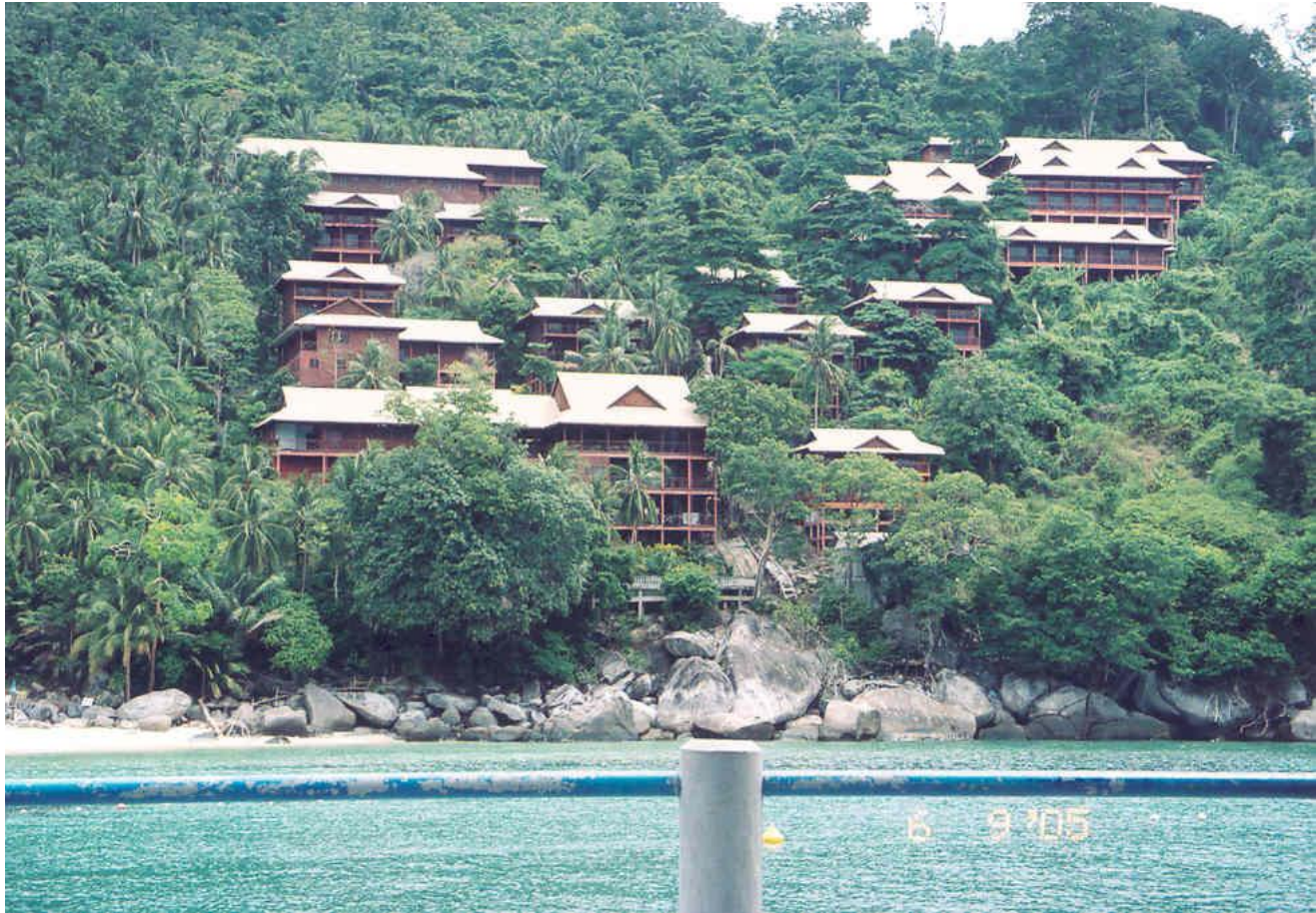

The Malaysian Government is facing conflicts between economic growth and environmental deterioration.





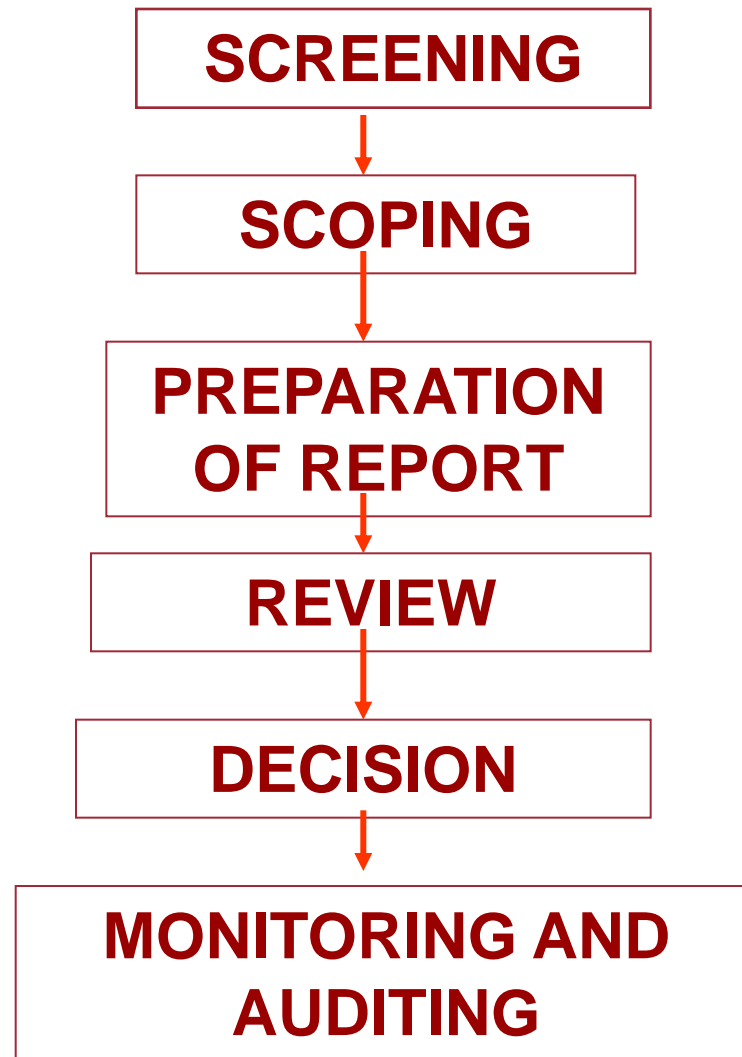
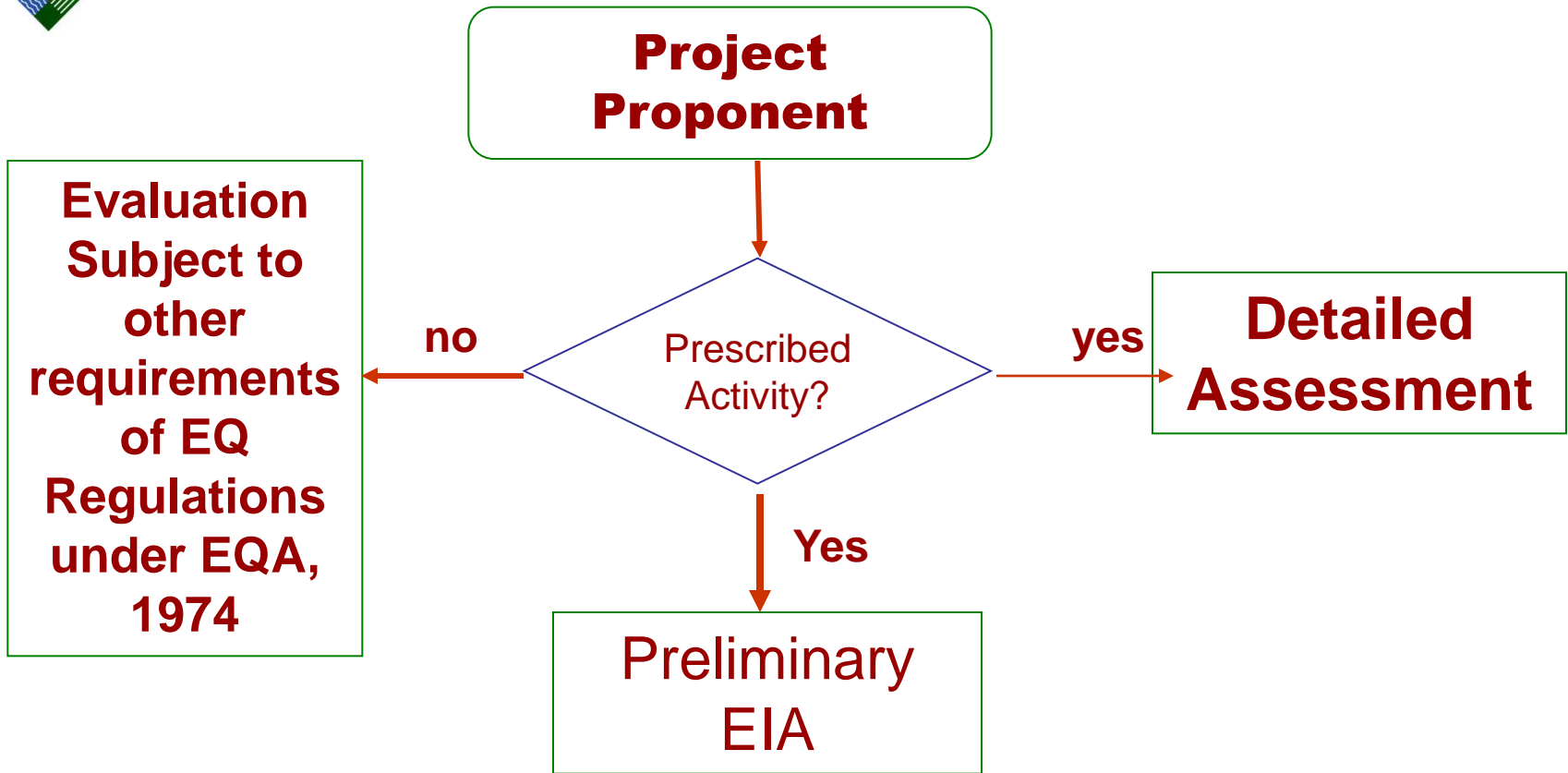


Figure 1.0. Stages of EIA

1. Term of references
2. Report display for public to comment
3. Review by expert panels



SCOPING

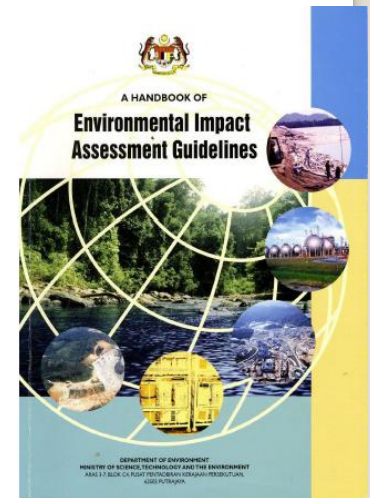
The aim:

evaluation.**



Preparation of EIA REPORT

- A handbook of Environmental Impact Assessment Guidelines
- EIA guidelines for specific prescribed activities
- registered EIA Consultants



REVIEW

- The reviewing exercise is formal process undertaken internally
- Including related government agencies and project approving authority
- For detailed EIA additional committee are expert panels and NGOs



DECISIONS

- Rejection
- or approval of the EIA report



MONITORING AND AUDITING

- **Checks on degree of implementation of EIA compliance**
- **Evaluation of success of mitigation measures**
- To identify whether **additional action** is needed to prevent unacceptable real impacts during project implementation.
