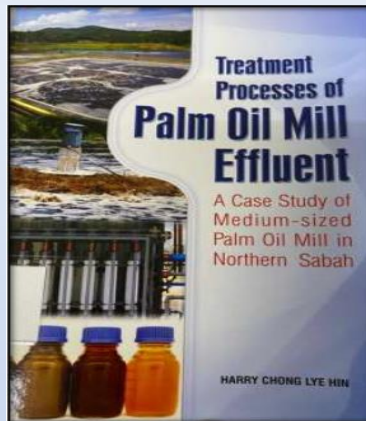

This book is a comprehensive written and edited by outstanding mind on the field of palm oil mill effluent. The case study's content is very good for overview in POME Treatment System that processes 210,000 MT of fresh fruit bunch (FFB) per year. The tables and pictures are very user friendly and the quality of colour photographs are very good.

Each chapter has a summary in treating raw POME. In other words, these data were subjected for crop seasons that created a range of readings for each analysed parameter. Towards the end of the chapter, a learned reader will understand how raw POME is treated in conventional medium-sized palm oil mill's POME treatment plant.
